Date of Report	February 10, 2015
Location	Buccaneer Ridge Apartments
Description:	ETSU Public Safety received a report on Tuesday, February 10, 2015 from a female student who reported she was robbed in the early hours of Sunday, February 8, 2015 while walking between J and K buildings at Buccaneer Ridge Apartments. She stated a small red car was following her and a black male exited the car, pulled a knife and demanded her belongings and fled in the same car.
Suspect Description	Black male, approximately 6 feet tall, 175 pounds, course voice, button back cap in black/red
Car Description	Small Red Sedan, Possibly a four door
