Upon further investigation by ETSU Public Safety, the sexual assault reported as occurring at an academic classroom building on September 14, 2016 has been unfounded. The complainant has stated the sexual assault did not occur.

Information about the sexual assault was shared via a Safety Notice to the campus community on September 15, 2016. The matter is under review by Student Affairs.

The Safety Notice is one aspect of ETSU's education and transparency efforts to raise awareness of sexual assaults and other Clery crimes. ETSU annually publishes Clery crime stats (found at: <https://www.etsu.edu/dps/documents/annualreport.pdf>). Safety Notices include educational/safety tips that may help someone from being the victim of a similar crime.
