

Research Track



Propel your career. Our student pharmacists collaborate with faculty on both lab-based and clinical research projects ranging from cancer studies to prescription opioid misuse. By participating in research, our graduates are distinguished from their peers when seeking residency or career positions. Students who complete requirements receive "Excellence in Pharmacy Research" notated on their official transcript.



Required: Students must have a GPA of 3.0 or highert to enter and progress in the Research Track. Students are eligible to enter the Research Track after successfully completing 1 semester of the research elective.



Application

Required: Sponsorship by a pharmacy faculty member to serve as research mentor. Electives are offered throughout the year and students register during normal Fall/Spring elective enrollment periods. Requirements

Complete 8 hours of course work including 6 hours of research electives + a 2 hour Capstone experience (PMIN 6361 or PMSC/PMPR 7300).



Timeline

Ы	Discuss interest in research with individual faculty
P2	 Enroll in Research I course with faculty mentor for 2 credits Register each subsequent semester for 2 credits in next level research course (II, III, etc.) If desired, students may change faculty mentors without loss of credit toward the Research Track
P3	Continue research coursework to complete at least 6 credit hours Apply for Research Track by P3 Spring semester
P4	Complete PMIN 6361Capstone Seminar or PMSC/PMPR 7300 longitudinally with faculty mentor
