Apply to ETSU

- « If you filled out an ETSU application this summer, just remember to turn in a copy of your transcript with ACT scores (in a signed, sealed envelope) at a school visit.
- « If you haven't filled out the application yet, remember to fill out the paper copy (not the online one) and turn it in to UB.
- « Remember that this application will apply you for summer and for next year, so no need to apply again!
- « UB will pay your application fee, so *everyone should apply to ETSU* (even if you don't plan to Bridge)!
