### **VUB Fall Semester Information and Instructions**

Page three of the newsletter contains the VUB Fall Semester 2016 schedule of classes. It is very similar to previous semesters and it contains all the precollege class opportunities for most veterans to prepare for entrance into and success in a postsecondary program.

We will continue our basic math and English classes this semester by offering tutoring for those who need to brush up on their basic skills. Please call the VUB office to arrange this individual service. We will continue to provide tutoring for those who need additional preparation before taking the COMPASS test.

Please note that computer skills class meets twice per week, while the remainder (algebra, science, and stats) meets only once per week. Also note that the semester is ten weeks in length.

Check out the schedule and contact any VUB staff member if you have questions. You may register by phone.

We recommend that all participants register for at least two courses so

that you will receive the full benefit of the instruction and be better prepared when you enter a postsecondary program.

We have designed the schedule so you will be able to register for up to four different classes during a four-day period without class conflicts.

If you are in college already, keep us informed of your progress, call if you need help, and let us know if you change your address or phone number.

The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) is a US federal regulatory agency designed to monitor and prevent anticompetitive, deceptive or unfair business practices.

A recent article by the FTC, "10 Ways to Avoid Fraud", is a comprehensive list of practical tips for fraud avoidance.

- 1. Spot imposters.
- 2. Do online searches.
- 3. Don't believe your caller ID.
- 4. Don't pay upfront for a promise.
- 5. Consider how you pay.
- 6. Talk to someone.
- 7. Hang up on robocalls.
- 8. Be skeptical about free trial offers.
- 9. Don't deposit a check and wire money back.
- 10. Sign up for free scam alerts from the FTC at ftc.gov/scams
