1. Access the Help Menu

- Log into Navigate via GoldLink
- In Navigate, click the icon in the top right corner of the page. Use the Quick Search bar to search the Help Center Articles or click Explore the Help Center tile to launch the Help Center.
 - NOTE: From the Help Menu, users can explore Navigate key resource articles and highlights by clicking the quad icon articles
- Within the Help Center, there are seven categories:

 What's New, Strategic Resources, and EAB
 Experiences.








Help Documentation:
