Admission Requirements

Students seeking admission to the Radiography completion program must meet the following criteria:

- College GPA of 2.5 or better on a 4.0 scale on all transferable credit;
- Transcript(s)- proof of graduation from an accredited allied health professional program;
- Licensed for professional licensure in the discipline.
- 30 Semester Hours (10 Courses) must be completed through ETSU.
- General Education Core Requirements may be completed through ETSU or Community College, or any 4 year accredited College University.

Students must earn a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 in all courses (ETSU, including transfer) and published requirements for the major and/or concentration and the minor, if applicable.

## Admissions Requirements

**Students seeking admission to the Radiography completion program must meet the following criteria:**

1. College GPA of 2.5 or better on a 4.0 scale on all transferable credit;
2. Transcript(s) - proof of graduation from an accredited allied health professional program;
3. Licensed or eligible for professional licensure in the discipline.
