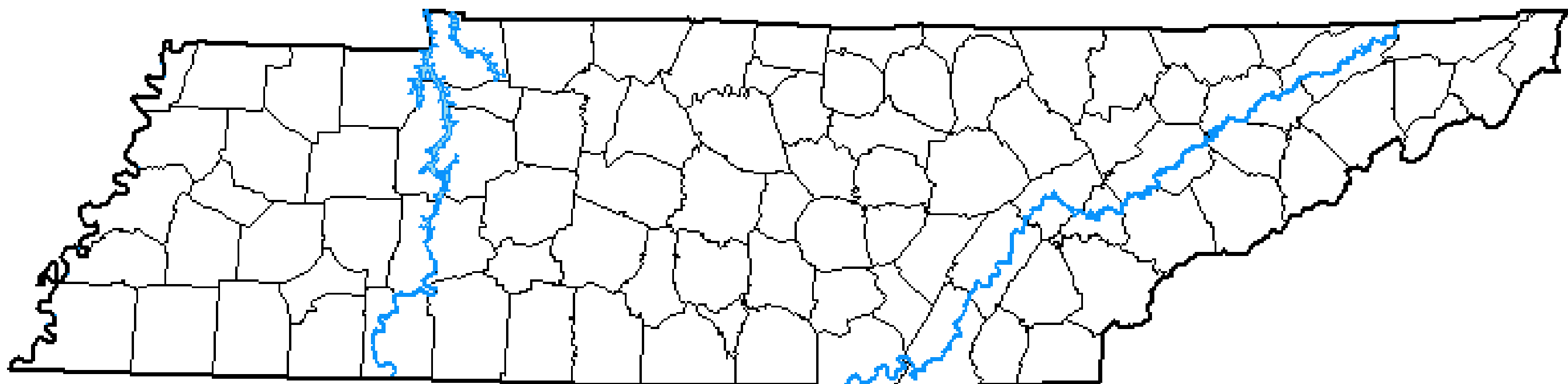


Tennessee Drought Update

For the assessment period ending January 31, 2023

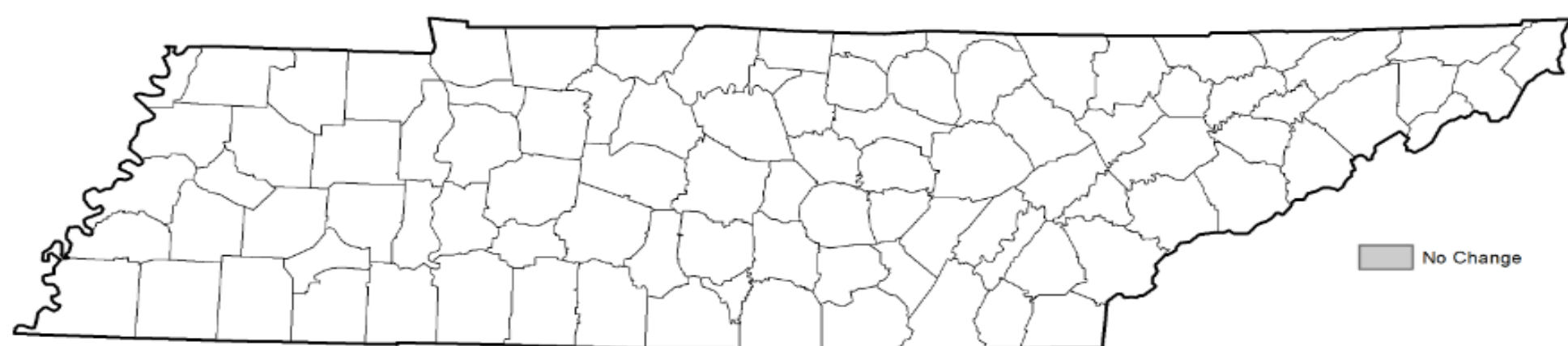
This Week's Drought Monitor of Tennessee Map

What's Changed? With rain and cool temperatures, there were no changes across Tennessee.

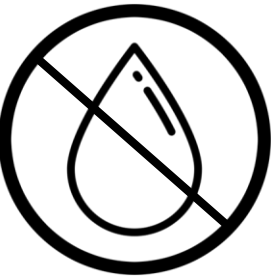
What's New? With the latest rain pushing through Tennessee, there was nothing new to report in the Drought Monitor this week.

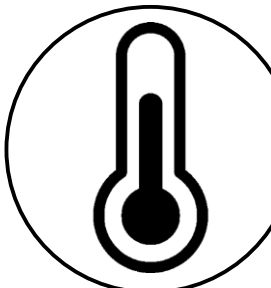

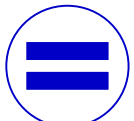
