- Which parts of the program you plan to participate in.
- What area of math you find most interesting (if any).
- Which applications of math or statistics you find interesting (such as physics, chemistry, biology, or economics).

The content of your essay will be taken seriously and you will not be rubber stamped into the program simply based on your GPA.

The requirement of an essay was approved by the Executive Board of the Honors College on September 12, 2008.
