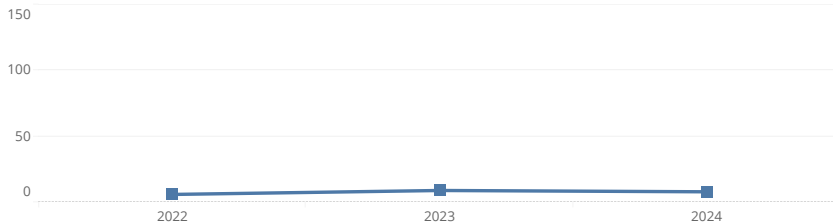

The Clemmer College of Education and Human Development provides a student-centered community of learning and development, reflecting high standards, and promoting a balance of education and professional practice through continuous improvement. The college conducts a wide array of academic programs, clinical, and community services including four research and practice centers and one of the nation's leading K-12 laboratory schools. Relationships are essential to our work as we provide the foundation to advance the level of educational attainment, healthy development, and well-being in the multi-state region, nation, and globally, based on our core values of collaboration, belonging, leadership, and scholarship.

The Instructional Leader Licensure Program is designed to prepare educators for beginning administrative positions at the PreK-12 campus or district level. Candidates advance through the program in a cohort model and work with professors, colleagues, and school districts to research, design, and lead innovative educational programs. Coursework, field experiences, and internship hours are aligned to TILS, Instructional Leader Literacy, and PSEL standards and invite students to study the principles of digital leadership, academic excellence, and social emotional learning. The 36-credit hour licensure program is offered at the M.Ed., Ed.S., and Ed.D. levels, with additional credits required to complete the degree programs. All of the instructors and the district-selected mentors have extensive experience in the field of instructional leadership, all serving as school principals. Internships embedded in the coursework total 540 hours and include district office; elementary, middle, and high school; and community agency settings. Successful completion of this program and the state-required assessment leads to the Tennessee Instructional Leader - Beginning license.

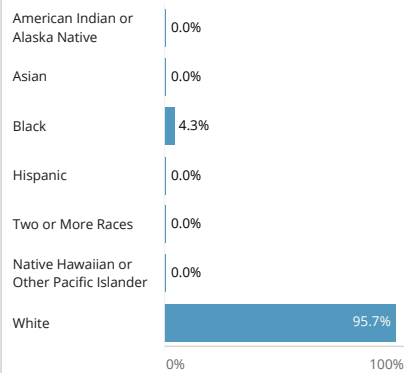

Cohort Members per Year

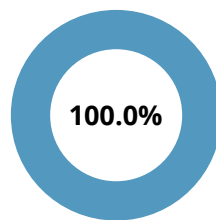

Completers by Race**What is this metric?**

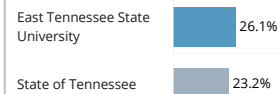
This metric shows the racial and ethnic composition of the three-year cohort.
