HSMP Suggested Program of Study

The MPH with concentration in HSMP can be completed in two years for full time students. Students must complete the MPH with concentration in HSMP within six years of matriculation to the degree program. The Field Experience (HSMP 5850) is a 300-hour placement at an appropriate governmental, non-governmental, non-profit, industrial, or for-profit setting that students complete in their second year. The HSMP Capstone (HSMP 5950) is the culminating experience for the MPH and it is completed in the last semester of the program. Students are advised to first complete the four MPH foundational courses. Electives are determined between the student and the MPH academic advisor.
