Our enrolled caregivers are paired with a community navigator that will connect them with resources, provide social support, and work with them to create goals for themselves and their family.

The navigator serves as an extra layer of support for families in the region. The early years in a child's life are crucial for their development, therefore, our team can continue to connect the family to resources that will help set the child up for success.
