RESEARCH SAFETY GUIDELINES


During the COVID-19 Pandemic



All researchers will be screened and will not be allowed to conduct in-person research if they are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms.



Participants will be screened for COVID-19 symptoms or exposure and will only participate in in-person procedures when presumed to be COVID-19 negative.



Social distancing is encouraged to the extent possible given the research activity and setting.



Face coverings should be worn during the interaction, and the researcher will provide a face covering for participants who need one.



Researchers and participants should wash hands or use hand sanitizers following completion of the interaction.



Researchers will identify any restrictions or requirements at the specific research location and how to meet them.



Researchers will take extraordinary care to disinfect any equipment that will be handled by researchers and participants.
