Undergraduate Academic Performance Agreement (UAS policy)

A student academically unsuccessful in two didactic and/or one clinical nursing course is **automatically** dismissed from the nursing program. They may appeal to the Undergraduate Academic Standards (UAS) Committee one time for readmission to the program. If the appeal is successful and the student is permitted to return to the program, the student is readmitted on probationary status and must sign an Undergraduate Academic Performance Agreement (UAPA). The UAPA is individualized to the student and includes actions and activities designed to optimize student success while they are on probation. Once an appeal is granted, the Academic Advisor notifies the student of the appeal decision. **When space is available in the program of study the Academic Advisor will** and meets with the student to outline the conditions of the UAPA. If a student does not agree to **and comply with** the conditions of the UAPA, the student will not be readmitted to the program.

- Documentation of required activities will be maintained using the Undergraduate Academic Performance Agreement Flowsheet.
- It is the student's responsibility to arrange then attend the meetings to satisfy the UAPA requirements.
- Faculty and/or advisors will maintain the Undergraduate Academic Performance Agreement Flowsheets documenting faculty/advisor meetings.
- Students will maintain the Undergraduate Academic Performance Agreement Flowsheets documenting tutoring sessions.
- All Undergraduate Academic Performance Agreement Flowsheets must be returned to the Chair of the Undergraduate Academic Standards Committee at the end of each semester.
