Broaden your understanding of health care. With the ETSU Doctor of Pharmacy (PharmD)-Master of Public Health (MPH) dual degree program, gain a broader perspective on health, with a special focus on disease prevention and health promotion strategies. Strengthen your ability to conduct and interpret research, serve in an applied public health setting, and develop knowledge and skills to address health and disease for the individual and populations.



Eligibility

Required:

- Bachelor's degree or higher (Gatton's bachelor's completion program is an option)

Application

Submit by **March 1 of P1 year** to Student Affairs:

- MPH program application available at etsu.edu/pharmacy/departments/pharmd_mph.php
- Application Fee paid to the School of Graduate Studies
- Personal essay of 150-300 words explaining reasons for pursuing PharmD-MPH program

Requirements

Complete three phases:

- Core courses (16 credit hours)
- MPH concentration courses (fourth year)
- Field experiences (fifth year of program, concurrent with advanced pharmacy practice experiences) and capstone
