## **SUPPORTING STUDENT SUCCESS SINCE 1991**

East Tennessee State University's TRIO McNair Program is funded by the U.S. Department of Education to expand access to doctoral students for talented undergraduates from low-income, firstgeneration, and underrepresented backgrounds since 1991.

The program is named after Dr. Ronald E. McNair, one of the astronauts killed on the ill-fated Challenger mission in 1986. Dr. McNair, the second African-American astronaut, was a proponent of education for hard-working, high-achieving students from all types of backgrounds.

The McNair Program provides opportunities for research and other scholarly activities and helps participants gain skills in areas designed to help them enroll and succeed in graduate school. Workshops are offered in graduate school admissions, presentation skills, professionalism, and research methods, among other topics.




### **SUMMER 2025 FACILITATORS**




