Institutional scholarship applications opened **October 1st** and are available for students who have been accepted to the institution. Now is the time to be filling out as many scholarship apps as you can! A few options with upcoming deadlines are:

- Ascent & College Confidential Campus Dream Scholarship -\$1,000 due Dec. 31st, 2024
- National Honor Society Scholarship - \$3,200-\$25,000 due Nov. 26th, 2024
- Driver Education Initiative Award
  \$500 due Nov. 30th, 2024
- Education Matters Scholarship -\$5,000 due Nov. 30th, 2024
- Beacon Scholarship for Rural America - \$1,000 due Nov. 30th, 2024
