**Instructions for viewing the Enrollment Scorecard**

**These tables provide a time-series look at our recruiting and enrollment efforts for Fall 2015.**

Tab 1 = Enrollment Snapshot from Registrar's Office

Tab 2 = Score Card

1. Block One (Enrollment Tracking to Fall 2015 Projection Score Card Rows 1-12) displays the Fall 2014 actual enrollment for UG and GR (Column B), then has tracking columns with indicators of growth, regression, or equal trends based on application at the UG level, and later registration for both levels, changes from Fall 2014 to Fall 2015 (Columns C-S), and finally the enrollment projected by the Markov chain projection. You can click on each of the indicators to see the actual change in applications or registrations.

2. Block Two (Enrollment Tracking to Fall 2015 Flat Goal Score Card Rows 13-24) has similar information but is tracking toward the goal of flat enrollment for Fall 2015 and as such will have different indicators depending on the level of applications. For example, for block one the indicator for total applications is flat, because the projection indicates a drop in enrollment and that is being supported by a decrease in applications. However, for Block Two, that indicator is negative because the goal is to maintain flat enrollment which would require at least flat applications.

3. Block Three (Success Markers: Undergraduate Students Rows 43-61) tracks our change in applications, and later registrations, based on some quality and residency indicators. You can click on each of the residency indicators to get the actual change in application values from Fall 2014 to Fall 2015.

4. Block Four(Success Markers: Graduate Students Rows 62-69) tracks our applications and later registrations, based on residency, for graduate students. PLEASE NOTE: THESE ARE FALL APPLICATIONS ONLY AND DO NOT INCLUDE SPRING AND SUMMER APPLICATIONS. You can click on each of the indicators to see the actual change in application values from Fall 2014 to Fall 2015.

Tab 3 = Application/registration Comp

This tab has the actual data used to generate the scorecard.

Tabs 4-14 are registration comparisons from Fall 2014 to Fall 2015 based on same day last year, by program. There are two tabs for each college one for Student Career (UG\_GR) and one for New vs Returning Students.
