I. Introduction.

Pursuant to Procedure G of the ETSU Policy Development and Administrative Rulemaking Policy, staff, faculty, or students may recommend that a policy be removed. After a legal review and review with appropriate parties, a written recommendation stating the reason the policy or procedure is obsolete is made to either Academic Council or University Council. The applicable council votes to either approve deletion of the obsolete policy or deny the proposed deletion.
