




#### Q2 In what year of school are you currently enrolled





#### Q4 What is your biological sex?






#### Q5 What is your current gender identity?







#### Q10 Did you transfer to this school from another school?





### Q11 Which of the following best describes your current grade point average?









## Q16 Since the start of this academic year, about how often have you consumed enough alcohol to get drunk?














